

Little Baddow Parish Council Photo Competition

Rules, Terms and Conditions

- Photos must be of anything as long as they are taken in the Parish. The location where the photo was taken must be supplied
- Photos can be colour or black-and-white
- Photos may be given a title, or not, as the photographer prefers
- Photos must have been taken by a resident, and not be subject to any copyright. Photos must be accompanied by the name and street address of the photographer. The address will never be published.
- Photos must be taken on public land or anywhere where the owner of the land/property has given permission.
- Any resident in the Parish can submit an entry
- Entries must be submitted in .jpg format.
- Up to 4 photos may be sent by email in any calendar month, to johninhollywood@talktalk.net (until further notice)
- Each calendar month, a small panel of Parish Councillors will select the 4 best photos (year 1) or the 3 best photos (year 2 onwards) which will be displayed on the home page for a period of between 2 weeks and a month. This choice by Parish Councillors is final.
- The chosen photos will be displayed on the home page of the Parish website, and any visitor to the website will be able to see the 4 photos together, or to click on any one to enlarge it
- Occasionally a photo may also appear in a Parish Council Newsletter, but will not be published elsewhere without the prior permission of the photographer.
- At the end of the year, all photos previously shown on the website will be displayed at the Parish Assembly. Every attendee at the Assembly will be able to submit one vote during the interval, and the winning photo (announced by the end of the evening) will be –
 - awarded a prize: this will be the latest available book of the national Wildlife Photographer of the Year winners.
 - displayed for the whole of the following year on our home page, alongside 3 entries for each month
- In the event of a tie in voting, the Chairman of the Parish Council will have an additional casting vote.
- Parish Councillors or members of their immediate family may not enter the competition.
